2 Screen speakers better: while the topic was of interest, the actual presentation was very poor - speaker seemed unprepared, read too much from his notes, and allowed his voice to drop to the point were he was mumbling.

3 1) The speaker was not dynamic at all. He was boring. He mumbled a lot and had his head down for most of the presentation. Suggest getting more dynamic speakers. Suggest having the speaker attend toastmasters. Presentation content was too basic for anyone but novice project managers.

2) Room set up was did not help with conversations. Classroom style limited mingling and meeting new people.

3) Without stealing the thunder from presenter, solicit input from audience. This is an experienced audience with much to contriubute to one another.
